**apa style manual, 6th edition: layout - morganc** - 1 apa style manual, 6th edition: layout margins & font margins are 1 inch on all sides. the recommended font is 12 point times new roman. title page the title is centered just above the middle of the page and double-spaced.

**apa 6th edition quick reference guide. version 4** - the apa manual does not give explicit instruction for the title page of a class paper. the contents and placement of items on the sample title page are adapted from apa instructions for the title page of a paper submitted for publication (publication manual, 2009, p. 41). title page layout (publication manual, 2009, p. 42-48 41) apa 6th ed.
